MEDICAL SUPPLEMENT PLANS

Outpatient Accident Coverage¹

\$0 Deductible per Accident Paid at 100% with a maximum of \$2,500, \$5,000 or \$10,000

Inpatient Benefits¹

DAY 1 CASH BENEFIT: \$500 or \$1,000 per day

DAYS 2+ CASH BENEFIT PER DAY: \$500 per day x 4 days, \$800 per day x 5 days or \$1,000 per day x 9 days

Critical Illness Benefits¹
